

The organ is well under way and the builders claim that part of it will be ready for shipment during the month of January. Mr. Charles Galloway of St. Louis is to be the official organist. Mr. Galloway has achieved an enviable reputation in a short time. A native St. Louisian, he has won fame as an organist both in Europe and America. His former instructor, M. Guil-mant, considers him one of the most tal-ented pupils he has ever had, and proved his regard for him by dedicating to him his sev-enth organ Sonata.

Among other distinguished organists who will appear are Eddy, Lemare, Dethier, Carl, Gerrit Smith, Horatio M. Parker, Middle-schulte, Wild, Whiting, and others of equal reputation. They will give recitals each morning.
