- Moved & seconded; that Rev. Mr. Arthur be given a present of two hundred dollars (\$200⁰⁰) as a recognition of his extra services, same to be paid out of the Special Fund - Carried -
- Moved; that Music Com. be authorized to engage organist; Carried -
- Moved; that Repairs & Supplies Committee be authorized to expend not more than \$35⁰⁰ for a hand rail for staircase to second floor - Carried -
- Moved; that the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100⁰⁰) be given to Foreign & Domestic Missions Society, & one hundred dollars (\$100⁰⁰) be given to Hospital Missions, in addition to amounts given during year ending Easter 05 - & that the balance of Easter offering be held in Treasury for disposition later on - Carried
- Moved; that bill of Kilgen & Son for tuning organ \$60⁰⁰ for 1 year to 7/1/05 - be approved & ordered paid - Carried -
