
Counterpoint & Composition Class Commences Sept. 18th 1908

The sentence, phrase, section, motive, expansion and contraction of sentence, etc., will be taught in a simple and plain manner, so it will be very easy for most any student to comprehend and arouse their interest to inspire their thirst for a more thorough knowledge of musical sciences and art.

At the end of the course, private and public demonstrations will be arranged to give evidence of the students achievements in producing their own compositions of the lighter form: as Chorals, Gavottes, Rondos, Sonatas, Dances, etc., etc.
