

St. Peter's Parish St. Louis Mo. 12-1909

The Vestry meeting postponed from Dec. 9th held in the ~~morning~~ Memorial, & opened with prayer by the Rector - Present Rev. Mr. Garrett & Messrs. Blake, Ford Judson - Miller Sheldon & Upshaw. Report of Treas for Feby read showing Receipts - \$3475.37 disbursements \$1490.09 balance Dec 1st 1985.28 and referred to Aud. Com. Treas. instructed to send bills to St. Peter's & St. Mary's Guilds for 6 mos. telephone service @ 1⁵⁰ pr. month to 3/30/09 - Rep of Sup Com. submitted bid for ~~conspicuous~~ heating & pipe covering at an additional expense of \$125⁰⁰ and on motion duly seconded same was accepted & Com. instructed to go ahead with the work as planned. On Motion it was ordered that Easter offering be for the heating plant & other expenses; & Music Com. reported a misunderstanding on the Galloways part regarding the contract for music & tuning organ, & on motion duly seconded the Com. authorized to arrange that the Parish pay for tuning organ, & for sheet music - Pew Com. reported several Pews rented - Secty read letter of Mr. A.M. Philon resigning as Vestryman & on motion duly seconded same accepted - Mr. J.R. Barroll nominated to succeed Mr. Philon & duly elected. Secty. read letter from St. Peter's Guild relating to tablet to Dr. Short & moved & seconded that Secty be instructed to say that the Vestry want to honor the memory of Dr. Short & we will be happy to see it placed outside the church. It was moved & seconded that the Vestry sympathize with the Finance Com. in their effort to build the tower and leave the matter in the hands of the Finance Com. to carry out - The Vestry then adjourned
