Regular Vestry meeting postponed from Apl. 8th held in

income of this Parish was \$60624.15 last year and Recty instructed to
write the Editor for information as to same, & how it may be corrected.

Moved, seconded, & carried that Compensation of Mr. Charles Galloway
Organist & Chorimaster be increased 400⁰⁰ primum beginning Apl. 1st 1913
and that the Music Com. express to him the Vestry's appreciation & regard.

Moved & carried that if it becomes necessary for the Rector to make
trips to investigate possible curate that his expenses be paid by
the Parish.

the Vestry then adjourned.
