It is a great privilege to have with us again the Rev. Dr. Karl Reiland, Rector St. George's, New York. Dr. Reiland will be the noonday preacher at the Columbia Theatre the coming week, and will also conduct the Preaching Mission in St. Peter's Church beginning to-night and continuing through Thursday night. Members of the congregation are urged to set aside this entire week in order that they may come and bring their friends to hear Dr. Reiland's inspiring message.

Dr. Reiland will conduct a service for "Men Only" at Christ Church Cathedral at 4 o'clock this afternoon. The men of this parish are invited to come and bring their friends.

In order to avoid misunderstandings, it is announced that the Mission Services to be held at St. Peter's this week will begin promptly at 8 o'clock and will consist of the singing of hymns, with a very short informal service. The main features of the Mission will be the sermon by Dr. Reiland and the answering of questions placed in the Question Box.

There will be no services at Epiphany Chapel to-night or Wednesday night on account of the Mission here in St. Peter's. The congregation of Epiphany will join with our own congregation in these services.

All persons desiring to be confirmed are requested to give their names to the Rector as soon as possible. It should be the earnest desire of every member of this congregation to bring at least one person to Confirmation. Can we not make this an ideal to be striven for by all who participate in the services this coming week?

The Bishop will visit St. Peter's Church for Confirmation on the third Sunday after Easter, being the 14th of May.

The Rev. Dr. Floyd Tomkins has conducted a wonderful Mission during the past week at the Church of the Ascension. The attendance at the Noonday Services at the Columbia Theatre has been excellent all week. Dr. Tomkins is a tremendous power for righteousness in his own city (Philadelphia), and his sojourn in St. Louis has proved a real inspiration to the large number of people who have come under his influence.
