Moved & carried that Music Com. submit contract for new organ to Mr. Judson before signing same - Moved, & carried, that the price agreed on for organ shall be total cost of same - all work to be done by the builders -

Moved & carried - that payments on organ shall be not to exceed \$3000⁰⁰ for first payment and balance to be in 4 annual instalments -

Moved & carried that recommendations of Rep & Sup. Com. for repairs, improvements &c. be approved up to \$1300⁰⁰ -

Treasurer requested permission to change safe Sp. box from Miss. Valley N. Co. to St. Louis Union N. Co., and that Mr. Sheldon name be added to list of those having access to same, and on motion duly seconded, it was so ordered.

There being no other business, to come before it, the Vestry then adjourned.
