

St Peter's Parish, St. Louis June 13th 1916
 A Special meeting of the Vestry, called by
 the Rector held at 8⁴⁵ Am. at the Church-
 Present Messrs. Ford, Bachmeyer, Judson, Price,
 Garrison, Lonsdale, William Barrell & Sheldon
 Meeting was called for the purpose of deciding on
 location of the new organ Messrs. Kellogg, organ
 builder & Galloway, organist were also present.
 It was found that to bring the organ case out into
 the Church, in the right transept, would seriously
 mar the appearance of the Church, and the Vestrymen
 present, unanimously decided that the better plan
 would be to divide the organ and put the Choir
 organ in the passageway to the Choir-room, and to
 put in a front with pipes on the left side of the Chan-
 cel, to match those on the right - This change
 was so ordered by the Committee and the
 Vestry adjourned
