

St. Peter's Parish, St. Louis Nov. 4th 1920

Called meeting of Vestry held in Parish House at 8 P.M. -

Present, Rev. Dr. Phillips, Messrs. Ford, Blake, Boehnken, Bridges, Garrison, Lonsdale, Miller, Pettengill, Price Sheldon & Williams.

Meeting opened with Prayers & directing collect by the Rector. Minutes of meeting 5/11/20 read & approved. meeting of 5/25/20 approved as corrected, by striking out all after third line of last paragraph of minutes; minutes 9/14/20 read & approved.

Treasurers reports for Sept. - Rec. \$3262.30 Exp. 1695.03 Bal. \$1567.27
and " Oct. - " 6260.74 " 3153.18 " 3107.56

Acty. Treas. Sheldon asked permission to transfer safe deposit box to Mortgage Trust Co's. Vault; moved & carried this be done.

The Rector appointed Mr. Boehnken acting Chan. Finance Com. Board, seconded & carried, that Choirleader Galloways remuneration be increased \$700⁰⁰ pr. yr. making total amount \$700⁰⁰.

Moved seconded & carried that Mrs. W. W. Wilson be appointed Housekeeper for Parish House at a salary of \$25⁰⁰ pr. month.

Secretary read a letter from Mrs. Frank R. Rice, of appreciation for the memorial tablet erected to his memory in the Church. and on

Motion, seconded & carried, her letter ordered made a part of the minutes.

Mr. Boehnken of Com. for raising purse for Bishop Johnson, on his going to Lambeth Conference reported \$785⁰⁰ raised & sent to the Bishop. & Com. discharged with thanks, for its good & effective work.

Mr. Price, Chan. Nation Wide Campaign Com. reported total pledged for first year \$15634.33 - for 3 years \$37021.00 & prospective 3 yrs. Pledge \$4840⁰⁰ or total for 3 yrs. \$41861.00 or 58% of our apportionment

Matter of obtaining men outside of Vestry to go after the balance of the amount desired, discussed & the Rector apptd. Mr. Price Chan. Messrs. Garrison Sheldon & Blake, to be a Com. to select the men & push the matter to a finish. No further business coming before it, the Vestry then adjourned. Charles Miller Secy.
