Moved sec. & carried; Treas. & Actg. be bonded in sum of \$5000⁰⁰ each, and the
Treas. of Epiphany Chapel in sum of \$1000⁰⁰ - the Parish to pay Premium.

Moved. sec. & Carried. that the Parish pay to Diocesan Treas. 1/12 of amount due
on Diocesan Assessment - Diocesan Missions, & General Church Program
each month - provided funds are on hand to do so -

Moved, sec. & Carried, Treasurer be instructed to remit \$25⁰⁰ to ^{not check} Chmn. St. Peter's
Branch Church Periodical Club on ^{not check} May 1st 1924 -
