To a rare lyric soprano voice she adds a brilliant mind and spirituelle beauty so distinctive that American critics are unable to separate her charming personality and her voice. Mme. de Vescovi in her New York debut repeated her previous successes in Paris and Rome.

**Christmas Vespers**—St. John's Methodist Episcopal Church—Tuesday afternoon, December twenty-ninth, at three o'clock.

**Mid-Winter Concert**—Odeon—Tuesday evening, February ninth, at half-past eight o'clock, a program will be presented by the club assisted by Royal Dadmun, baritone. Mr. Dadmun made his first appearance in St. Louis with the Morning Choral Club last season. His instant success has led to a return engagement.

**Benefit Scholarship Loan Fund**—Wednesday Club—Friday evening, March nineteenth, and Saturday afternoon, March twentieth. Tickets one dollar.

**Spring Concert**—Odeon—Tuesday evening, April twentieth, at half-past eight o'clock the club will be assisted in its program by Rafaelo Diaz, tenor of the Metropolitan Opera Company. Mr. Diaz is an American by birth but received his vocal education under Vincenzo Sabatini the famous Italian maestro. Mr. Diaz is a versatile recitalist with a genuine lyric tenor voice of unusual warmth and purity.
