

## FINE ORGAN IS HERE.

### Presbyterians Soon to Enjoy Strains of \$6,500 Instrument.

Two special representatives of Lyon Healy, Chicago, today will begin unloading and setting up the new \$6,500 organ which has been purchased for the new First Presbyterian church. It is expected that about three weeks will be consumed in completing the work.

The organ is of the style which is used in many of the best churches of the country. It is said to be the most satisfactory instrument which can be had at reasonable cost. The different parts, boxed for shipment, occupy two furniture cars. These arrived Saturday.

Prof. J. W. Mather has charge of the music at the church. He is already making plans for special music to be given to the accompaniment of the new instrument. Soon after the organ is installed two recitals will be given by one of the leading organists of this country, Charles Galloway, of St. Louis. Mr. Galloway, who is a former soloist of Guilman, was official organist at the St. Louis world's fair.
