CHRISTMAS CAROLS TO BE FEATURE OF RECITAL

Christmas carols will be the feature of the public organ recital of Charles Galloway at Graham Memorial Chapel, Washington University, Sunday afternoon, at 3 o'clock.

An "Offertoire on Christmas Carols," by Alexander Guilmant, will be the opening number. The number comprosises three French carols, where "Noels," as Christmas carols are called in France, are very popular.

The other numbers will be, "Sonata in E Minor," by James H. Rogers; 'Evening Song," by Edward C. Bairstow; "Badinage," by Alphonse Mailly, and "Processional March," by Whitney.

Rogers is a Cleveland composer and organist. He composed the sonata in twenty-five minutes. Mailly is organist at Ste, Gudule at Brussels and professor of organ in the conservatory in that city. Whitney introduced the English cathedral service in the Church of the Advent, Boston, where he was organist for thirty years.
