

DEDICATE ORGAN AT IOWA FALLS ON THURSDAY EVENING

Iowa Falls, Ia., July 5.—(Special)—The new three-manual electro-pneumatic pipe organ for the Congregational church here, which cost \$10,000, will be dedicated by Prof. Charles Galloway of St. Louis in recital Thursday evening, July 10.

Mr. Galloway is one of the most prominent organists in the United States today. He was the official organist of the world's fair in St. Louis in 1904. He played pipe organ for church services when he was 12 years old, and was then known as "the boy organist."

Besides this new addition, the Iowa Falls church is distinguished by having a vested chorus choir of over fifty voices, which is conceded as one of the best and largest in the state. The Congregationalists are indeed fortunate to have such combined musical facilities for their church services.
