cal)—The new three-manual electro-pneumatic pipe organ for the Congregational church here, which cost \$10,000, will be dedicated by Prof. Charles Galloway St. Louis in recital Thursday

evening, July 10.

Mr. Galloway is one of the most prominent organists in the United States today. He was the official organist of the world's fair in St. Louis in 1904. He played pipe organ for church services when he as 12 years old, and was then hown as "the boy organist."
