

## Yesterday's Recital.

Charles Galloway of St. Louis, a noted organist and pupil of Guilmant, gave a brilliant recital on the great organ in the Temple of Music yesterday afternoon, which was heard by an appreciative audience that filled the spacious building. He was especially effective in a number of Guilmant's compositions, including the magnificent "Funeral March and Song of the Seraphs." Master Frank Clegg, a celebrated boy soprano, of Toronto, sang "The Lost Chord," "Onward, Christian Soldiers," "Nearer, my God, to Thee," and "Abide With Me." He is a handsome boy, and a sweet singer.

Mr. Galloway will play again today and tomorrow. Other organists who will be heard during the week are A. Ray Tyler of Brooklyn; William C. Schwartz of Philadelphia and Benjamin J. Lang of Boston.
